Dr Frank Stenning has been a clinical consultant with Sydney Breast Clinic since 2008. He graduated in medicine from the University of Sydney in 1960, and was then admitted as a fellow of the Royal Australasian College of Surgeons having trained at Royal Prince Alfred Hospital in Sydney.

Frank specialised in abdominal upper GI surgery. He practiced in the USA and UK prior to returning to Australia as Acting Professor of Surgery at the Austin Hospital in Melbourne in the early 1970s. He was a consultant surgeon for the Pan-Pacific Surgical Association (1975-79) and the International Committee of the Red Cross, ICRC, Geneva (1979-1990).

He was a visiting medical officer in general surgery for Bowral and Southern Highlands Private Hospitals, and has more recently been involved in medical education in Africa as part of Specialists without Borders.
